Returning as committee chair in 2006, he assisted in organizing the 2006 Prestonian Lecturer's Western Canada tour.

Inaugural speaker to the Canadian Academy of Independent Scholars, his work has been published in *The Traveller Magazine* (2007), *Martial Arts of the World, An Encyclopedia of History and Innovation* (2010) and *Ars Quatuor Coronatorum* (2009). His onscreen appearances have been limited to a brief appearance in *Riddles in Stone* (2007) and the occasional interview for CBC TV.

As library and museum curator, a position he has held since 1996, he has created a comprehensive cataloguing system and programme for the display and preservation of our collections. Grand Historian since 2005, he is also currently the chairman of the Grand Lodge Library and Archives Board of Trustees.
